VIRGINIA: IN THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE CITY OF HAMPTON

RULE OF COURT


IT APPEARING to the Court that the order heretofore entered on May 31, 1973, and amended effective July 1, 1983, setting procedures to be used on and after the effective date of the change of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Virginia to the Eighth Judicial Circuit of Virginia should, because of the addition of a fourth judge in the Circuit, effective July 1, 1995, be changed in certain particulars.


NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED, that the said order of May 31, 1973, as amended, be, and it is hereby changed and amended, effective July 1, 1995, in the following particulars:

1) The second paragraph of Paragraph 5 (h) of the said order is changed to read as follows: "Effective July 1, 1995, it is understood that the Clerk of the Eighth Judicial Circuit will continue to maintain on Index to Deeds, etc., one Judgment Lien Docket book, and one Index to ended causes in chancery and actions at law. As may seem most convenient, separate Common Law and Chancery Order Books and dockets may be maintained for Part I, Part II, Part III, and Part IV of the Eighth Judicial Circuit. The present Circuit Courtrooms now designated as Part I, Part II, and Part III shall remain as now designated, and, initially, the Courtroom located in the General District Court Building of the City of Hampton, and in place of that courtroom the new facilities to be constructed in the present Circuit Court Building, when the same become available, as the Courtroom for Part IV.

2) The Clerk of this Court is directed to make appropriate notations of the entry of this order in the places in the order books of this Court where the said order of May 31, 1973 and its amendment, are spread.

The foregoing changes to the prior plan of consolidation are adopted and established
